2020 Artist Trading Card Submission Guidelines

The theme for the 2020 Artist Trading Card Show is MAGIC OF THE ORDINARY

Theme Statement:

This year's theme should inspire you to use your artwork as a poetic tool for observation. We sometimes forget to appreciate the things we observe around us. Notice and record simple, everyday objects and phenomena: the way light falls on a curved surface, your refrigerator magnets, the bowl on the kitchen counter with overripe fruit. What does the magic of the ordinary mean to you? Use your imagination and creativity and share your interpretation!

General Guidelines:

- Artist Trading Cards are miniature works of art completed on a 3.5" x 2.5" form. Blank cards supporting various mediums (watercolor, acrylics, collage, pen) are available for free and can be picked up at the Arts Council office, while supplies last. To arrange for curbside pickup of cards, please email Neelam at education@kodiakarts.org or call/text 907-942-5840.
- Artists may submit up to five entries in the Artist Trading Card Show.
- Entries are due Tuesday, Dec. 1st, at 4 pm at the KAC office inside the Gerald C. Wilson Auditorium.

- The Artist Trading Card Show will be exhibited virtually. An in-person component of the exhibit at the Gerald C. Wilson Auditorium may be possible depending on community risk levels.
- The Artist Trading Card show will end of Friday December 18th. Artists will be notified by email when any unsold or not-for-sale works are ready to be retrieved.
