> In this class we will learn the wax resist method of silk painting. Focusing on process we will experiment with color, play with pattern, and experiment with the natural flow of dye on silk. Students will have the opportunity to experiment & gain skills on a series of smaller silk pieces before working on a full-size silk scarf and creating their own wearable art!

JULY 19 PRINT MAKING

Explore printmaking and a few of its many possibilities: Mono prints and block prints. Taught by local art teacher, Bonnie Dillard. In this class students will learn various carving, inking, and printing techniques to create a series of prints on paper and cloth. Color theory and design will be incorporated into the process of printing.

FISH N' PRINT JUNE 9

WITH KODIAK MARINE CHARTERS

JUNE 16 8:30 am or 1 pm | Age 9 to 13

Tuition: \$80 (half-day, 4 hours) **JUNE 23**





Get out on the water and discover new creative inspiration through this special program combining fishing and arts activities. Gyotaku is the Japanese art of fish printing. Fishermen in Japan invented this art form as a way to record the size of their catch. Ink was applied directly to the fish, and the image was printed on rice paper to memorialize the moment. In this camp, students will fish for rockfish with Kodiak Marine Charters aboard the Moonlight, a 43' Delta Coast Guard Inspected vessel, and then return to the harbor to create their own fish print - on paper and on a t-shirt! Students will go home with their art and vacuum packed fillets of fish!
